The undersigned, Thomas McRae, Clerk of the Circuit Court of Madison County, Illinois certifies that on the 7th day of January, 2021, the Circuit Court for the Third Judicial Circuit, Madison County, Illinois did order that the following question be submitted at the general consolidated election to be held within the territory described in said Order on April 6, 2021 in accordance with the general election law, which question shall be in substantially the following form:

For disconnecting from the Bunker Hill Fire Protection District and organizing the Dorsey Fire Protection District and retaining a proportionate share of the bonded indebtedness, if any, of the former district.

ORDER DIRECTING ELECTION

This matter having come before the Court for hearing on the Petition For The Disconnection of Territory From The Bunker Hill Fire Protection District and For The Organization of a New Fire Protection District To Be Known as The Dorsey Fire Protection District, and the Court having considered said Petition and being advised in the premises, the Court does find as follows:

1. That the Court has jurisdiction of the subject matter of this proceeding pursuant to Section 1 of the Illinois Fire Protection District Act (the "Act") (70 ILCS 705/1).
2. That notice of the hearing on the Petition was published on December 18, 2020 in the Edwardsville Intelligencer, a newspaper of general circulation in the area proposed to comprise the proposed Dorsey Fire Protection District, pursuant to the Order of this Court entered on December 8, 2020 setting the Petition for hearing; that said publication meets the requirements of Section 1 and Section 16(c) of the Act; and that the publisher's certificate of publication has been filed herein.
3. That notice of the hearing on the Petition was served on the Board of Trustees for the Bunker Hill Fire Protection District, and that the Certificate of Service of such notice has been filed herein.
4. That notice of the hearing on the Petition was posted in 10 conspicuous locations within the area to comprise the Dorsey Fire Protection District and in 10 conspicuous locations in the remainder of the Bunker Hill Fire Protection District, and that the Certificate of Service of such posting has been filed herein.
5. That the material allegations of the Petition are true and correct, to wit: that the Petition is signed by one percent (1%) or more of the legal voters residing within the area

proposed to comprise the Dorsey Fire Protection District; that the area proposed to comprise the District is contiguous and located within Madison County, Illinois; that the territory is so situated that the destruction by fire of the buildings and other property within the said territory is hazardous to the lives and property of the public therein; that the territory is so situated that the acquisition, establishment, maintenance, and operation of a fire station or fire stations, facilities, vehicles, apparatus, and equipment for the prevention and control of fire in said territory will be conducive to the promotion and protection of the health, safety, welfare, and convenience of the public; that the territory would receive equal or greater benefits from the district in which it seeks to be organized, that the disconnection of territory will not cause the territory remaining in the Bunker Hill Fire Protection District to be noncontiguous nor impair such district from rendering fire protection district service to the territory remaining in the district, and the trustees of the Bunker Hill Fire Protection District have consented to the disconnection not more than 90 days prior to the filing of the petition by resolution which is attached to the Petition.

6. That the territory proposed to be included within the said fire protection district is described as follows:

All territory of the Bunker Hill Fire Protection District presently located in Madison County, Illinois, excepting the eastern half of Section 1 of Moro Township, specifically Parcels 16-1-03-01-00-000-002 and 16-1-03-01-00-000-003.

7. That the Petition complies with the provisions of Section 1 and Section 16(c) of the Act.

8. That no objections to the Petition have been filed or presented to the Court upon the hearing in this cause by persons residing in or owning property within the territory proposed to comprise the proposed fire protection district.

Having so found, it is ordered as follows:

A. That there be presented to the voters residing in the above described territory proposed to comprise the Dorsey Fire Protection District the question of whether to disconnect said territory from the Bunker Hill Fire Protection District and organize the territory into a proposed fire protection district at the general consolidated election to be held on April 6, 2021 in accordance with the provisions of the general election law and the question presented to the legal voters at such election shall be in substantially the following form:


For disconnecting from the Bunker Hill Fire Protection District and organizing the Dorsey Fire Protection District and retaining a proportionate share of the bonded indebtedness, if any, of the former district.	
----- Against disconnecting from the Bunker Hill Fire Protection District and organizing the Dorsey Fire Protection District and retaining a proportionate share of the bonded indebtedness, if any, of the former district.	

B. That the Circuit Clerk of Madison County is directed to certify to the County Clerk of Madison County, Illinois the above and foregoing question for submission at the general consolidated election on April 6, 2021 in accordance with the general election law of the State of Illinois.

C. That the County Clerk of Madison County shall give notice of the referendum and the above question which notice shall specify the purpose of the election and shall include a legal description of the proposed fire protection district in accordance with the general election law.

D. That a written statement of the results of the said election shall be filed of record with the Court by the Madison County Clerk in accordance with the general election law.

E. That the Court retains jurisdiction of this matter for the purpose of receiving the results of the election and carrying out the terms of this Order and the requirements of law applicable thereto.
