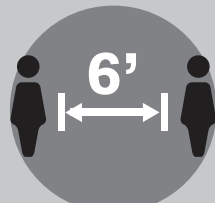

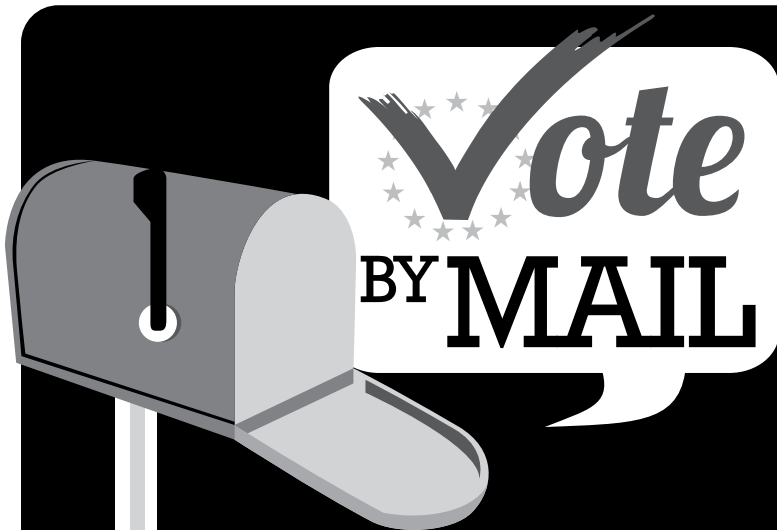

TO HELP REDUCE THE SPREAD OF COVID 19, 2021 CONSOLIDATED ELECTION VOTERS ARE ENCOURAGED TO CAST A BALLOT PRIOR TO ELECTION DAY, EITHER BY MAIL OR DURING EARLY VOTING.

In order to allow more people to vote from the safety of their own homes, you can request a vote by mail ballot by e-mail, mail, on-line, or in person.

IT IS SO EASY . . . If you are registered to vote in Madison County, you are eligible to cast a ballot by mail.

In addition, the following registered voters are eligible to vote by mail:

- Members of the Armed Forces or Merchant Marine and their spouses and dependents whether serving in the United States or abroad whose permanent residence is in Madison County;
- U.S. citizens and their spouses or dependents, whose permanent residence is in Madison County but who will be temporarily residing abroad on Election Day;
- U.S. citizens (not their spouses or dependents) who maintained a residence in Madison County immediately prior to their departure from the United States.

Am I Eligible to Vote?

To be eligible to vote in Madison County, you must register. The County Clerk's Office processes all voter registration applications for Madison County residents.

You Can Register to Vote if You Are:

- A United States citizen.
- 18 years of age by the next Consolidated Election (April 6, 2021 Election).
- A resident of your Madison County precinct address for at least 30 days immediately prior to an election.

Two forms of identification are required to register. At least one of the two forms must show your name and current address. Only one form of identification may be a piece of mail postmarked within the past 30 days which has been addressed and delivered to you.

Acceptable forms of identification include, but are not limited to, the following:

- Register by mail or in-person at the County Clerk's Office, 157 North Main Street, Edwardsville, IL 62025.
- Through a Deputy Registrar duly appointed by the County Clerk.
- At your local municipal or township office and other local agencies.

Voter Information Changes

Keep us up-to-date with you!

Your voter registration does not expire unless you move or change your name.

Name Change: Should you change your name by marriage, divorce or other legal name change, you must re-register under your new name and provide the new signature on your registration record. Two forms of identification with your new name are required, one of which must have your current address.

Address Change: If you move within Madison County, you must provide written notification of your new address and sign the request:

- Mail notification including your name, old and new address, date of birth and your signature or,
- Complete the back of your voter registration card including your signature.

If you move to Madison County from another county or another state, complete a new registration application. The County Clerk's Office is required to verify the accuracy of the voter rolls. On the odd year, every two years, this is accomplished by mailing notices to all registered voters to confirm their residency at the address on file.

Voter Registration Cards: Your Voter Registration Card is routinely mailed to confirm new registration, voter updates or changes in polling places.

State law requires the Election Office to mail out voter cards to all voters every two years. The maintenance mailing is done to ensure only valid registrations for voters are listed in the voter field.

This Has Multiple Goals:

- Make sure a voter's registration is complete and up-to-date before the voter tries to vote.
- Clean the voter file of no longer valid registrations.
- Speed up Election Day sign-in process by shortening the list of voters given to judges.
- Reduce costs in the election budget by requiring less ballots and supplies to be printed.

Every registered voter should have received a new card. The new card should be checked to make sure the name and address of the voter is up-to-date. If it is not, the voter will need to change their registration before the election.

Voters are also reminded that if they do not receive a card but feel they are registered, there are a couple of common issues why they did not receive a card.

- Their registration information was not updated after moving to a new address.
- They had a P.O. Box listed on their registration that they no longer use.

Voters are asked to return cards sent to a person who no longer resides at an address. All that is required is your signature and a note stating the voter no longer lives at the address so the voter's registration can be removed.

Grace Period Balloting

If I Didn't Register, Can I Still Vote?

If you did not register to vote or update your address, you can now do that on Election Day at the polling location for the address where you currently reside. You must have two forms of identification, one with your correct address. You will complete a Voter Registration Application, provide your two forms of identification to the election judges and you will then be able to vote. If you are not sure of the polling location for your address, please contact the County Clerk's Office at **618-692-6290**.

What to Expect At the Polls

Voting should be a quick, satisfying experience if you follow a few simple steps. Here are some tips of what to expect at the polls on Election Day:

- You are required to vote in the precinct where you live. Your Voter Registration card shows your precinct number and polling place location. It can also be found on our website. The polls are open from 6 AM - 7 PM. To avoid the heavy turn-out times of 6 AM - 9 AM and 5 PM - 7 PM, we suggest you vote between the hours of 10 AM - 4 PM.
- To ensure a quick process, any changes to your name or address since the last election should be updated with the Election Office 30 days prior to Election Day.
- When you arrive at your precinct, an Election Judge will ask your name and address, find your name in the poll book and ask you to sign an application to vote. Your application to vote will be numbered and your ballot will be initialed by an Election Judge.
- It is important that you review your ballot for accuracy prior to casting your ballot. Once your ballot has been accepted by the voting equipment, no further changes or corrections can be made.
- If you made a mistake, you can "spoil" the ballot you have by giving it back to the judge and getting a new ballot. You can ask any questions you have to the Election Judge.
- If you registered through the mail and the Election Office could not verify your identity, you will be required to show one form of identification from the following list:
 - A current and valid photo ID
 - Utility bill
 - Bank statement
 - Government check
 - Paycheck
 - Government document

Voter Responsibilities

Each Registered Voter In This State Should:

1. Familiarize himself or herself with the candidates and issues.
2. Maintain a current address with the office of the County Clerk.
3. Know the location of his or her polling place and its hours of operation.
4. Bring proper identification to the polling station in case it is needed.
5. Familiarize himself or herself with the operation of the voting equipment in his or her precinct.
6. Treat precinct workers with courtesy.
7. Respect the privacy of other voters.
8. Report any problems or violations of Election Laws to the County Clerk's Office.
9. Ask questions if needed.
10. Make sure that his or her completed ballot is correct before leaving the polling station.

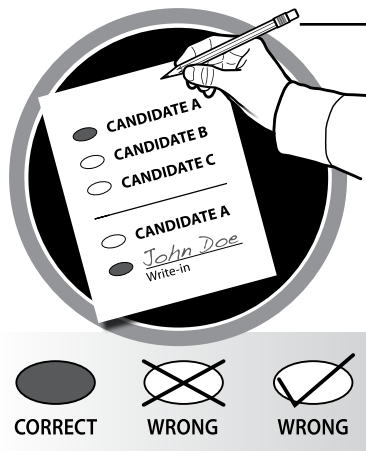
1. Go to www.MadisonVotes.com

Casting Your Ballot

1. **Receive your ballot:** Enter the polling place and give your name and address to an Election Judge. Complete and sign an Application to Vote. Upon verification, the Election Judge will give you:

- A paper ballot
- A privacy cover

2. **Enter the voting booth and mark your ballot:** Enter the next available voting booth. To vote the optical scan ballot, completely fill in the oval to the left of the candidate or public question of your choice. Be sure to mark both sides of your ballot if needed. If you make a mistake marking your ballot, return it to an Election Judge to receive a new ballot.



To Vote: Completely fill in the oval next to the candidate/ write-in/proposition of your choice(s) with the marking pen provided.

Write-in Votes: If you wish to vote for a person whose name is not on the ballot you may print the name of the candidate in the blank space below the office. Write-in votes are counted only for those candidates who file a "Declaration of Intent" to be a write-in candidate.

If you make a mistake and you need a new ballot: Return the ballot to an Election Judge who will provide you with a replacement.

3. **Vote!** Cover your ballot with the privacy sleeve and insert the ballot into the ballot tabulator. The Optical Scan System complies with the Help America Vote Act (HAVA) to provide voters an opportunity to check for and correct ballot errors (for example, casting more votes for an office than allowed will result in an overvote). If an error is detected, the system will gently beep and give you the option to accept the ballot as is (the overvoted office will not count) or you may return the ballot to an Election Judge and receive a new ballot.

FYI

- The ballot tabulator will notify you if you have overvoted an office or undervoted a State office. Many voters intentionally skip offices where they do not care to vote for more candidates than allowed in any given office. You can either count the ballot as is or go back and check your ballot.
- The "paper trail" provided by this system of voting is not a receipt for the voter, but instead an actual ballot which can be recounted when necessary to ensure the integrity of the system.

Voter Bill of Rights

YOU HAVE THE RIGHT TO:

- ★ **Cast your ballot in a non-disruptive atmosphere** free of interference.
- ★ **Vote if you're in line by 7 PM.**
- ★ **Be a provisional voter** if there is a question about your registration status or your eligibility to vote in the election.
- ★ **Vote a Federal ballot at your old polling place** if you have moved within 30 days of the election.
- ★ **Request assistance in voting**, if needed.
- ★ **Bring newspaper endorsements or sample ballots into the voting booth**, but take them with you when you finish voting.
- ★ **Protect the secrecy of your ballot** by using the ballot secrecy folder provided.
- ★ **Receive a new ballot if you make a mistake** or change your mind.
- ★ **Check for voting errors** (overvotes) after marking your ballot in a private and independent manner.
- ★ **Have your ballot counted fairly** and impartially.
- ★ **If you believe these rights have been violated**, call the Madison County Clerk's Office at **618-692-6290**.

The Vote by Mail Balloting Process

- You need to verify your Voter Registration to get an Application to Vote by Mail.**
- Get an Application to Vote by Mail.**
Applications to vote by mail will be available 90 days before the election.
- Fill out and send application to Vote by Mail to the County Clerk's Office.** There are two ways to complete an application for ballot to Vote by Mail. Open www.MadisonVotes.com. Click on **Vote By Mail** link, verify your registration, and then download either the Mail-in paper application or download the E-mail application that you send to us as an attachment.
- After we receive your application,** a packet with an Official Ballot, Instructions for Voting, certificate envelope, and a return mailing envelope will be mailed to you. Our office will not mail ballots more than 40 days or less than 5 days prior to the election.
- Vote by Mail ballot packet.** When you get your Vote by Mail ballot packet, follow all instructions on how to vote and return the ballot to the County Clerk's Office. Your ballot must be postmarked by Election Day and received within 14 days after the election. If you personally deliver to the County Clerk's Office, the ballot must be received no later than Election Day.
- Accept/return Vote by Mail packet.** Vote by Mail ballot packets must be complete. They are often returned because the application is not signed, the application is not included, no signature is on the affidavit or the ballot is not in the official affidavit envelope.
- Ballot is ready to cast.**

Who is Qualified to Vote By Mail

If you are registered to vote in Madison County, you are eligible to cast a ballot by mail.

In addition, the following non-resident voters are eligible to vote by mail:

- Members of the Armed Forces or Merchant Marines and their spouses and dependents whether serving in the United States or abroad whose permanent residence is in Madison County;
- U.S. citizens and their spouses or dependents, whose permanent residence is in Madison County but who will be temporarily residing abroad on Election Day;
- U.S. citizens (not their spouses or dependents) who maintained a residence in Madison County immediately prior to their departure from the United States.

Military and Over Seas Voting: Members of the Uniformed Services and their family members or U.S. citizens residing overseas whose last known address is in Madison County and wish to Vote by Mail may do so by completing an FPCA (Federal Post Card Application). After completing the application, please send it to the County Clerk's Office via one of the options below:

By completing this application, you will automatically be sent a Vote by Mail ballot for one calendar year.

Nursing Home Voters: The County Clerk's Office provides election judges to conduct in-person Nursing Home voting to (registered) residents at participating nursing homes. Voters must be a permanent resident registered at the nursing home address.

Disabled Voters: Illinois State Statute requires voters who are permanently disabled to complete an Application for Absentee Voter's 5 Year Identification Card form* along with an Affidavit of Attending Physician* in order to automatically be sent a Vote by Mail Application for every election within five years after we receive the application.
**Form must be notarized*

Hospitalized Voters: If you enter the hospital 14 days or less before an election, you can have someone deliver a ballot to you. Contact our office at 618-692-6290 to find out more.

Personal Delivery of My Ballot: You may authorize any person to return your ballot to the County Clerk's Office as long as you sign the affidavit on the back of the envelope authorizing that person to do so.
