### **CIRCUIT COURT:**

J. Parente presented the following:

1. An Ordinance Adopting a Fee to Support the Court Appointed Special Advocates (CASA) Fee.

Ms. Dalton moved, seconded by Ms. Glasper, to approve the ordinance as presented. The ayes and nays being called on the motion to approve resulted in a vote as follows: AYES: Goggin, Dalton, Davis, Glasper, Walters and Asadorian. NAYS: None.

### **CIRCUIT CLERK:**

M. Von Nida reported that the different departments of the courthouse had a Christmas tree decorating contest. The voting was based on how many can goods could be collected. The total amount of can goods that were collected was 5,800 and 5 different food pantries benefited from it.

### **SHERIFF:**

R. Hertz presented the yearend report to the committee. There were 18 fewer bookings than last year. The total number of inmates for the year 2013 was 6,356.

### **STATES ATTORNEY:**

S. Smith gave a few yearend statistics for the department. She reported they were up on felonies; DUI's were down from last year. There were 8 murders for the year, which is low compared to years past. Heroin death cases are the same as last year's total.

Circuit Court is purchasing additional (\$206.00) components for the document camera system. The cost is \$5,489.97.

Mr. Walters moved, seconded by Mr. Asadorian, to approve the bills as presented. The ayes and nays being called on the motion to approve resulted in a vote as follows: AYES: Asadorian, Glasper, Walters, Davis, Dalton and Goggin. NAYS: None.
